The exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power."

The second word of encouragement is grace. Ephesians 2:6-7 says God "raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus."

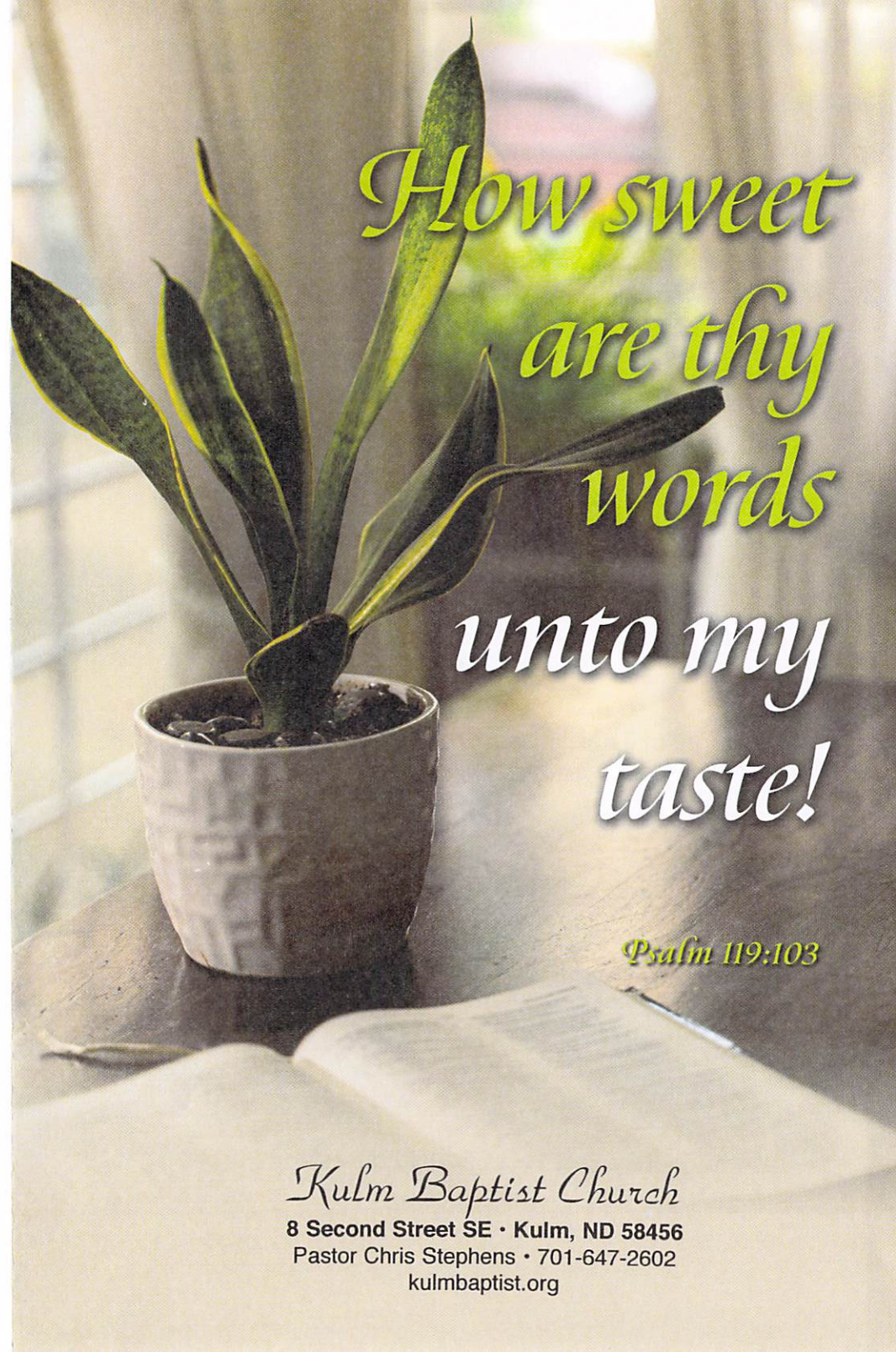

The fourth word is glory. Most earthly glory is short-lived, as some have their fifteen minutes of fame, but for one who has come to faith in Christ, there is glory that will last forever.
